## Sample On-Campus Schedule

While on campus, students will remain in their grade-level cohort groups and will not have contact with other grade-level students.

Students will transition to each teacher's classroom for instruction.

Schedule	On-Campus Sample Day
8:00-8:45 1st Period	Science
8:50-9:35 2nd Period	Literature (drop day)  Drop days allow students time to study or work on long-term assignments. There will be no new class or homework on these days.
9:40-10:15	Chapel Smaller groups of students will attend chapel on designated days, and all other students will watch chapel via live stream in classrooms. There will be designated outside locations for a break during this time each day.
10:20-11:05 3rd Period	Vocal
11:10-11:55 4th Period	Algebra
12:00-12:45	Lunch One grade will eat in the dining hall each day while other students eat in classrooms.
12:50-1:35 6th Period	History
1:40-2:25 7th Period	French
2:30-3:15 8th Period	English

## Sample Remote Learning Schedule

Students at home will be expected to follow the same schedule as learners on campus; however, they will only be expected to join class via Google Meet a maximum of three times per day by joining their class' Google Meet link. The other four classes each day will be asynchronous, and students will work independently to complete the daily required lessons and assignments. Because we realize that remote learning presents its own unique challenges, we created this schedule to allow some flexibility in work time throughout the day while at home. Remote learners will be able to contact teachers for assistance and will have additional time throughout the week to work with teachers one-on-one if needed.
