How to Play: Participation is optional. Challenge yourself to read more this summer by playing St. Mary's Summer Book Bingo. Any time you read a book that fits one of the categories on your card, make an $x$ in that box. On the back of the card, write the title of the book that matches the category. If you want to play multiple cards to see where you get the BINGO first, a link to additional cards is on the Lower School division page.

The goal for girls in grades 1-5 is to complete one line (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal). When you complete five boxes in a row (BINGO), bring your card to the library during summer checkout hours or the first week of school to receive a small prize. If the category requires you to create a product, bring it with your card. Each student may "BINGO" a maximum of 5 times. Students can choose to complete one full card (BLACKOUT BINGO) to be entered in a drawing for a special prize ( 5 winners will be drawn.)

As long as the book fits the category in some way it counts, BUT you may only use a book once per card, even if it fits more than one category.
