Sample Remote Learning Schedule

Students at home will be expected to follow the same schedule as learners on campus; however, they will only be expected to join class via Google Meet a maximum of three times per day. Remote learners will join their synchronous courses by entering their class' Google Meet link to join together with on-campus learners. The other four classes each day will be asynchronous, and students will work independently to complete the daily required lessons and assignments. Because we realize that remote learning presents its own unique challenges, we created this schedule to allow some flexibility in work time throughout the day while at home. Remote learners will be able to contact teachers for assistance and will have additional time throughout the week to work with teachers one-on-one if needed.
